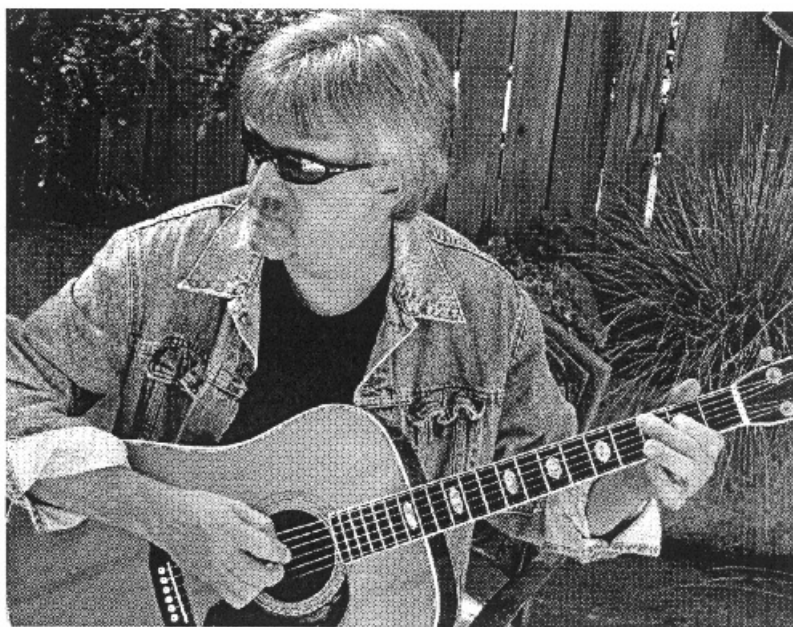




## **Daniel Mark Faller**

Daniel Mark Faller was born in Seattle, Washington in 1952. As a youngster he witnessed Elvis and the Beatles on Ed Sullivan and made the decision early on to be a lifetime musician. After moving to Lewiston, Idaho in 1972, Daniel began to get more serious about music and after singing throughout North Central Idaho as a solo musician, he joined his first band in 1976. Spending the next 28 years playing the nite clubs and community events of North Central Idaho, Daniel began to develop an original vocal style that has been known to turn heads at any venue. He can take a song by any artist, and make it completely his own. He has also developed an original song writing style that expresses his country feelings while adding a little bit of rock and roll bite. Now Daniel has built a state of the art studio in his home and he has vowed to release a CD a year for the rest of his life. With the release of "Amber Waves" in October of 2004, he is off to a good start. Watch for Daniel's performances with his partner, Marty Lukenbill. You WILL enjoy.

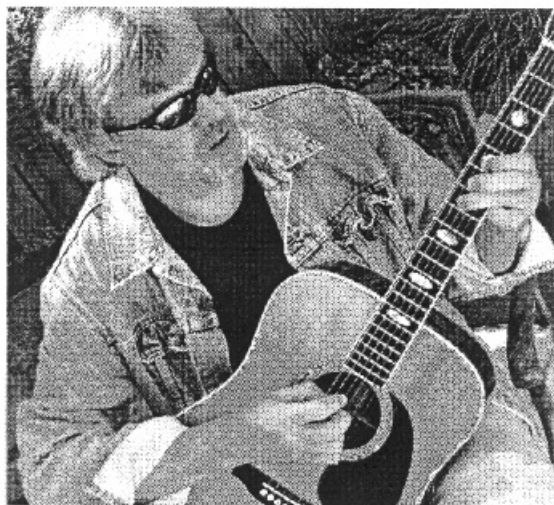

## **Daniel Mark Faller**

### *Musical Resume'*

- 1975-1976: "Dan Faller & His Martin" / played solo around the Lewiston, Idaho area. Material consisted of originals and folk such as Bob Dylan and Woody Guthrie.
- 1976-1977: "Rainbow" / lead singer in a 4 piece country band playing the North Idaho region from Mcall to Moscow. Material consisted of Waylon Jennings, Willie Nelson, The New Riders of the Purple Sage, Merle Haggard, Marshall Tucker and more.
- 1977-1982: "The Stretch Wabash Band" / this band made a slow transition from a country band to a full production southern rock band. It began with Rainbow's song list and wound up doing Lynrd Skynrd, the Outlaws, Pure Prairie League, Tom Petty, Marshall Tucker, and various top 40 rock material. It was with this band that Daniel first got in some quality studio time doing a demo at Eastern Washington University and another at Red Wing studios in Encino, California.
- 1982-1992: "The Seidel Brothers Band" / this was a multi talented group of 3 brothers who hired Daniel as their lead singer. They covered everything from Buck Owens to Bruce Springsteen and enjoyed a massive following in the Idaho panhandle. In 1984 the band recorded an album of 11 originals at Phil Mattson studios in Spokane, Washington. Daniel wrote 6 of the songs including the title song, "See it in Your Eyes". They sold over 1000 copies off the bandstand at their shows.
- 1995-2002: "The Big Newtons" / this 4 piece band performed the greatest hits of the 60's and 70's and enjoyed incredible 3 part harmony with material from the Beatles, the Hollies, Herman's Hermits the Rolling Stones, the Beach boys and more. They still come out of retirement 2 or 3 times a year, and when they step on stage, the magic is still there.
- 2001-Present: "Lukenbill-Faller" / this is a duo with the other guitar player of the Big Newtons. The live show is similar to the Big Newtons with a list from Jimmy Buffett to Pink Floyd. They released a CD in 2003 of 16 original songs and it has sold over 500 copies to date.
- 2004-Present: "Daniel Mark Faller" / Daniel is returning to his country rock roots and doing some solo shows on open dates. He released "Amber Waves" in the fall of '04 with 6 originals and 6 hand picked covers. He has vowed to release a CD a year for the rest of his life.
